Preamble

This policy is designed to align with the principles of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) Code of Conduct while ensuring full compliance with local laws and relevant international regulations.

SmarAct is committed to safeguarding the environment by integrating sustainable practices into our operations, minimizing our ecological footprint, and complying with relevant environmental regulations and standards.

Pollution Prevention and Resource Use

SmarAct takes proactive steps to minimize waste, emissions, and resource consumption in its operations.

We make continuous efforts to identify and prevent any pollutants entering the environment from our facilities.

We design our products with sustainable design principles in mind, thus ensuring that natural resources are used sparingly.

Waste

SmarAct works with professional waste management companies to ensure responsible treatment, recycling and disposal of waste.

We diligently separate waste to ensure that valuable materials can be recycled.

Hazardous Substances

We commit to eliminating hazardous materials from our products if possible. When complete elimination is not feasible, appropriate measures are taken to prevent harm to human health and the environment.

We document and control the use of hazardous substances to ensure their safe handling, storage, and disposal.

Materials Restrictions

We adhere to applicable material restrictions regulated by local and international authorities and in accordance with our customers' needs.

We maintain continuous communication with our suppliers to ensure that our products are free of minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas, in adhering to the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas.

We request our suppliers to provide up-to-date information on the use of hazardous substances listed in REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 and RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU.

We maintain a close relationship with our customers to identify and properly address any further customer-specific material restrictions.

Water Management

SmarAct is committed to responsible water usage in all operations.

All machinery that requires water operates in closed-loop systems and allows recirculation of the medium for many operation hours.

All used water-based media are conscientiously collected and professionally treated, thereby preventing contamination of waterways.

Air Pollution

SmarAct takes active steps to monitor and control emissions of air pollutants, including regular maintenance of the air ventilation systems and monitoring all work areas for sources of air pollution.

We power all our production machinery with electricity, thereby avoiding air pollution associated with fossil fuel combustion, such as ozone, nitrogen dioxide, sulfur dioxide, and carbon monoxide.

We do not use any ozone-depleting substances regulated by the Montreal Protocol and support the commitment to safeguarding the stratospheric ozone layer.

Energy Consumption and Greenhouse Gas Emissions

We track our energy consumption across all steps of business operation and continuously look for opportunities to optimize energy use and reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHG).

We commit to transitioning all our operations to being powered by renewable energy.

We adhere to GHG Protocol standards and guidelines for accounting for our GHG emissions and commit to setting a science-based GHG reduction target.

Biodiversity

SmarAct recognizes the importance of biodiversity on the local and global scale.

We commit to minimizing the impacts of our business operations on biodiversity and contributing to maintaining and restoring native ecosystems whenever possible.

We aim to integrate biodiversity considerations into our facility development and thereby support the resilience of local ecosystems.

Extended Producer Responsibility

As a responsible manufacturer, SmarAct ensures that our products are designed for long life and repairability.

We take responsibility for our products at the end of their life by offering take-back programs and providing relevant information about safe disposal, in line with the WEEE (Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment) Directive 2012/19/EU.

The packaging of our products is made of recycled and recyclable materials whenever possible. We continuously optimize our packaging to minimize waste for our customers, while keeping our products safe from transportational damage.
